
Féile Luimnigh - Instrumental Section

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REGULATIONS

- 1. Entries must be made online, which must be completed in every detail.
- 2. While students of all ages are encouraged to participate, all entry forms must include a teacher's name who can certify that the entrant is of the relevant standard and age.
- 3. The committee reserves the right to refuse entries if any classes are oversubscribed. Entries will be accepted in the order received. The committee also reserves the right to cancel a class if it is undersubscribed.
- 4. All correspondence is encouraged to be made via email to <u>feileinstrumental@gmail.com</u>.
- 5. The **CLOSING DATE** for all entries is November 22, 2023
- 6. Competitors entering Féile must be of **AMATEUR** status only. An amateur is considered to be one who does not derive the main part of his/her income from performing as an instrumentalist. However, holders of Diplomas (Performers' or Teachers') ARE eligible to take part.
- 7. The Committee reserves the right to appoint replacement or additional Adjudicators and Official Accompanists.
- 8. The order of competing will be decided by ballot, and times and dates of competitions together with competitor order will be published on the website three weeks prior to the festival.
- 9. No competitor will be permitted to perform more than once in the same competition.
- 10. Competitors may only enter one age category per year (e.g. an 8 year old can enter either under 9 or under 11, but cannot enter both competitions).
- 11. A competitor who wins a competition may not enter that competition again. The exceptions to this rule are the Conducted Ensembles competitions and the competitions which have changed this year: Brass, Winds, and Recorder.
- 12. Age restrictions are applicable to the competitor's age on **1 January**, **2024** i.e. u/11 (under 11) means up to and including age 10 in 2024.
- 13. Competitors may not play the same piece in more than one competition with the exception of the Intermediate and Advanced Open Recital competitions.
- 14. Competitors should not begin their performance until the Adjudicator so indicates. The Adjudicator may also stop the performance at any point.
- During Féile, any enquiry or representation to the Adjudicator must be made only2024 Féile Luimnigh Instrumental Syllabus

through the Féile Committee Representative.

- 16. Video, sound recording, and photography are not permitted during the performance or adjudications.
- 17. **MARKS**: All Competitive competitors will receive adjudication and a written report.
- 18. **CUPS** may be awarded to winners gaining a mark of 85% or over. Prizes may be withheld at the discretion of the Adjudicator, whose decision in all cases will be final. Cups will be presented at the end of the adjudication. Cup winners will be required to sign a safe custody and safe return undertaking for each cup awarded. All Cups from previous years must be returned to a Féile Committee Representative, properly cleaned and in good repair by **Friday**, **December 8**, **2023**. Suitable inscription, preferably on the plinth where appropriate, is permitted at the holder's expense.
- 19. An original or copy of 'own choice' music must be made available to the Adjudicator at the beginning of each competition.
- 20. **COPYRIGHT ACT.** The Music Publishers' Association has issued a revised Code of Practice on photocopying copyright works, and the following concession is made for photocopying: Own Choice pieces from VOLUMES ONLY for the Adjudicator. Other items must not be photocopied without the permission of the copyright holder, usually the Publisher: "When an Own Choice work is selected from a publication containing several different works and which is not published separately, one copy may be made for the use of the Adjudicator, provided that the competitor has already purchased his/her own copy, and that the photocopy is retained and destroyed by the Administrator immediately afterwards."
- 21. The Committee reserves the right to:
- Disclaim all responsibility for injury or damage sustained by any competitor or member of the audience, or for the loss of music or personal effects not collected at the end of each session.
- Decide all other matters connected with the conduct of the Féile not provided for in these regulations, and reserves the right to change or cancel any rules or arrangements it deems necessary for the smooth running of the Féile.
- Cancel and refund any entry due to oversubscription or undersubscription of classes. In no other case is the entry fee refundable.
- Decide on all questions or disputes arising out of or not provided for by these rules, which shall be final.

^{*} We respectfully ask that, where stated, time limits are adhered to. When performers overrun this causes significant problems for the running of the competitions, including the timetables for adjudicators and accompanists, the venue, and is also unfair on all those competitors who have respected the time constraints. Competitors who overrun are at risk of either being stopped mid-performance or of having marks deducted.

ARRANGEMENTS FOR ACCOMPANISTS

- 1. Féile Luimnigh provides Official Accompanists.
- 2. If intending on using the Official Accompanist you must mail or hand deliver printed copies of "choice pieces" by **Friday, December 8, 2023**. Please supply clear copies of your chosen pieces, pages taped together (if necessary), with the competitor's name, teacher's name, and competition details clearly marked. After this date, Official Accompanists are not obliged to play for a performer.

- 3. Please send an email to let us know if you are **not** using the Official Accompanist for your competition.
- 4. We strongly recommend arranging a rehearsal with the Official Accompanist in advance, the Official Accompanist will be announced with the timetable three weeks prior to the competition. The fee for a rehearsal with an Official Accompanist is €12.50 per 15 minute rehearsal, €25 per half hour rehearsal and €50 per one hour rehearsal. Only one rehearsal is permitted per competitor with the Official Accompanist.

Advanced Open Recital

Competition 2

Open to solo performers of any instrument, no age restriction.

Entry Fee €35

Winner will receive €250 Bursary

Competitors may perform music they are performing in other competitions.

NOTE: Competition will be held on Saturday, February 3.

A programme of at least two pieces (or movements) that is of a minimum Grade 7 standard, not exceeding 15 minutes.

- 3. No official Accompanist is available for this competition, but teachers may accompany the students themselves or arrange their own Accompanist.

Requirement: One piece, not exceeding 3 minutes.

NOTE: This is open to students of all levels who do not wish to compete with others in their own instrument, or those who do not fit the criteria for existing Competitions. **Limited spaces available.
